COVID-19: WHAT TO DO IF...

NOTE: These scenarios may be adapted for individual circumstances or to align with new health department guidance.

Scenario #1

**STUDENT IS
CONFIRMED POSITIVE**

IMMEDIATELY ISOLATE

Stay home for a minimum of 10 calendar days after symptom onset or positive test collection, whichever is later. Return to school with written release from the St. Charles County Health Department.

Scenario #2

**A FAMILY MEMBER IN
THE STUDENT'S HOME
IS CONFIRMED POSITIVE
OF QUARANTINED**

IF A FAMILY MEMBER IS CONFIRMED POSITIVE - IMMEDIATELY QUARANTINE

Stay home and quarantine for 14 calendar days after last exposure.

IF A FAMILY MEMBER IS QUARANTINED – COME TO SCHOOL

If a family member is quarantined in the student's home because they were in close contact with an infected person (but the family member has not tested positive), the student should continue coming to school.

Scenario #3

**A CLASSMATE IS
CONFIRMED POSITIVE**

IF CLASSMATE WAS A "CLOSE CONTACT" – IMMEDIATELY QUARANTINE

A "close contact" is any individual who was within 6 feet of an infected person for at least 15 minutes, starting from 2 days before illness onset (or for asymptomatic patients, 2 days prior to positive test) until the time the patient is isolated. Close contacts must stay home and quarantine for 14 calendar days after last exposure.

IF A CLASSMATE WAS A "CONTACT" – COME TO SCHOOL

"CONTACT" means student was in the same room or general vicinity as an infected person, but not within 6 feet for more than 15 minutes. Continue coming to school. Self-monitor for symptoms and continue safe hygiene and PPE practices.

Scenario #4

**STUDENT HAS CLOSE
CONTACT WITH
SOMEONE WHO IS
SYMPTOMATIC (NOT
POSITIVE)**

COME TO SCHOOL

Self-monitor for symptoms and continue safe hygiene and Personal Protective Equipment (PPE) practices. If the original symptomatic person receives a positive result. Follow quarantine procedures outlined in Scenario #2.

Scenario #5

**STUDENT DEVELOPES
SYMPTOMS OF COVID-19**

STAY HOME / GO HOME

If symptoms develop while at school, the individual will be given a face covering, isolated 6 feet from any other person, and the parents will be notified immediately so that the individual can return home. If at home, stay home until symptom free for 24 hours without medication. If they test positive for Covid-19, follow the quarantine procedures in Scenario # 1.

If someone on school grounds has contracted COVID-19, all staff and families will be notified. Attendance policies will account for the special circumstances of COVID-19. If a student needs to stay at home due to COVID-19 concerns, teachers will work with the child/family to ensure make-up of assigned classwork. The student will not be penalized for their absences or be subject to any academic restrictions.

IF A STUDENT TESTS POSITIVE FOR COVID-19 OR IS UNDER QUARANTINE ORDERS, THEY CANNOT RETURN TO SCHOOL UNTIL RELEASED BY THE HEALTH DEPARTMENT.
